#### **Examination Schedule**

- 1. Mid Term Examination will be conducted in September according to the given syllabus.

- 5. Periodic test will be of 30 marks, second term and the Annual Exam will be of 80 marks [Sixth to Eighth].
- 6. Duration of Periodic Test will be of 1 hour, second term and the Annual Term will be of 2 hours. (Pre Nursery to Fifth).
